


Idea:

• Muscle weakening through removing a segment of IO thus receding it and preventing its local reattachment.







Indications:

- IOOA. (1ry, 2ry; symmetrical, asymmetrical ??)
- IOOA with v-pattern.
- IOOA with AHP.
- IOOA with DVD.



Pros:

- Easy.
- Short.
- Sutureless.
- "It takes care of what is there", "Self-adjusting effect"
- Residual IOOA following recession or ant. transposition. (nasal myectomy)
- Graded ??



Cons:

- Unpredictable.
- Inefficient in high deviation and DVD.
- Graded ??



Tips and tricks:

- Visibility.
- Blunt hooks.
- Hooking from insertion.
- Dissection.
- Disinsertion close to insertion.
- Measurement.
