


Cataract surgery after rupture globe and central corneal scar

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 H_{χ} :22 years old male with history of left eye rupture globe and corneal laceration repair 6 months ago

Examination

OS (+VE) DATA

- V/A :Hand motion with left exotropia
- Central corneal scar with 2 loose stitches and single large corneal blood vessel
- Distorted pupil, anterior and posterior syanechia with traumatic cataract
- No fundus view with moderate vitreous floaters on B-SCAN

<u>Patien preoperative counseling about visual prognosis and there would be</u> two sugeries: first cataract extraction then corneal transplantation
